This new restaurant was opened by the former chef/owner of "The Steps of Rome", Enzo Pellice. Enzo is a resident of Telegraph Landing, living at 156 Lombard.

Kathleen and I were pleasantly surprised with the ambiance and the friendliness of the entire staff, including the owner. We were greeted at the door by Angelo. When we hesitated about going in, he said "This is the best Italian food in town. If you don't like it, you won't have to pay for it." Needless to say, we were happy to pay for it.

We were both impressed by the variety of choices on the menu. Incidentally, this same menu is offered for "Take Out". We each enjoyed the Burrata Pomodoro & Rucola appetizer, for \$9.95 (Mozzarella, Cherry Tomatoes and Arugula). Kathleen had the fresh fish of the day, Halibut, and I had Agnello alle Erbe, three grilled lamb chops served with fresh Italian herbs. Both plates also included potatoes and spinach. Each dish was priced at only \$17.50. Which, by the way, is the highest price on the menu.

I thoroughly enjoyed the lamb chops. They were as tasty as any that I can remember. Kathleen also enjoyed her Halibut, but agreed with me that the lamb was truly outstanding.

For desert, we had Tiramisu and a fresh iced sorbet that was sensational.

We both will be going back soon. The quality of the food and the price are both hard to beat!
